Notice of Race

1.0 Rules

- 1.1 The Championship will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *"The Racing Rules of Sailing"*.
- 1.2 The Young 88 Class Rules apply to all boats racing in the Young 88 class.
- 1.3 The Pied Piper Class Rules apply to all boats racing in the Pied Piper class.
- 1.4 The YNZ Safety Regulations Part 2, Category 4 shall apply.
- 1.5 Single Handed Championship (24 May)
 - 1.5.1 – There shall be not more than one (1) crew per boat including the Skipper.
 - 1.5.2 – No Extras are permitted to be used during this event, only the use of Class Mainsail and #2 Jib are permitted. Use of Genoa or spinnaker not permitted.
 - 1.5.3 - Skippers shall at all times while racing wear an approved PFD or Lifejacket.
- 1.6 Double Handed Championship (7 June)
 - 1.6.1 – There shall be not more than two (2) crew per boat including the Skipper.
 - 1.6.2 – No Extras are permitted to be used during this event, Genoa / Jib Selection will be as per class rules and sail selection criteria and committee boat signals as defined in the sailing instructions Attachment 3 with the objective of ensuring safe and enjoyable racing.
- 1.7 Triple Handed Championship (19 July)
 - 1.7.1 – There shall not be more than three (3) crew per boat including the Skipper.
 - 1.7.2 - Sails will be as per class rules and sail selection criteria and committee boat signals will be defined in the sailing instructions with the objective of ensuring safe and enjoyable racing.

2.0 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of Young 88 Class whose owners are full financial members of the Young 88 Owners Association and with boats holding current valid measurement certificates, or to all boats of Pied Piper Class whose owners are full financial members of the Pied Piper Owners association.
- 2.2 The helmsperson must be a financial member of a member club of Yachting New Zealand.
- 2.3 For boats sailing in the Young 88 class the helmsperson must be a financial member of the Young 88 Owners Association.
- 2.4 For boats sailing in the Pied Piper class the helmsperson must be a financial member of the Pied Piper Owners Association.
- 2.5 Advance Series entries will be accepted until the normal closing date of 1600 hrs. Thursday 21 May 2020, by completing the attached entry form accompanied by a fee of \$100.00 for the full 1-2-3 series, and mailing it to BBYC, P O Box 54 005, The Marina, Auckland 2144, or emailing to racingentry@bbyc.org.nz
- 2.6 Individual event entries will be accepted until 1600hrs the Friday before each event by completing the attached entry form accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 per individual event, and mailing it to BBYC, P O Box 54 005, The Marina, Auckland 2144, or emailing to racingentry@bbyc.org.nz
- 2.7 Late entries may be accepted at the Race Committee's discretion.

4.0 Sailing Instructions

5.0 Racing Area

The races will be held in the area bounded by Rangitoto Island, Browns Island and Bean Rock. With the aim to be racing in the vicinity of Northern Leading Light.

6.0 Courses to be Sailed

6.1 Single Handed - Three short Harbour courses as outlined in the Sailing Instructions.

6.2 Double & Triple - Up to six (6) windward/ leeward races as outlined in the Sailing Instructions.

7.0 Scoring

7.1 Single Handed Championship - One (1) race is required to constitute the series.

7.2 Double & Triple Handed Championship - Two (2) races are required to constitute the series.

7.2.1 - When four (4) or less races are completed a boats series score will be the total of her race scores.

7.2.2 - When five (5) races are completed a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

7.3 1-2-3 Series Event - Two (2) races are required to constitute the series.

7.3.1 - 13 races are scheduled for the series.

7.3.2 - When four (4) or less races are completed a boats series score will be the total of her race scores.

7.3.3 - When five (5) races are completed a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

7.3.4 - When 12 races are completed a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two (2) worst scores.

9.0 Prizes

Prizes will be awarded at the Prizegiving at BBYC at the conclusion of racing on Sunday 19th June 2020.

10.0 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
