

## Bucklands Beach Yacht Club under Level 3 – Stage 1– 6th October 2021:

- The Bucklands Beach Yacht Club office will remain closed until further notice
- Meetings, workshops, or events are not taking place (unless an online option can be held)
- The restaurant and bar will be continued to be closed until we go back into Level 3 Stage 3

## Access that will be allowed to the BBYC Yacht Club buildings

- No access to the main BBYC Yacht Club building until further notice (other than toilet facilities via member card access, you must scan your QR code and the membership cards still only use your old card that expired 31<sup>st</sup> July 2021).
- No access to the Granger Point building.

## Access that will be allowed to the BBYC Yacht Club Marina

- Members with boats on the Marina can visit their boats, to do minor maintenance and safety checks, (including running engines), as long as you strictly stay in your bubble and keep social distancing and good hygiene methods
- Every Visitor must Sign in using the NZ Covid-19
  Tracer app. QR Codes are displayed on the Marina doors.
- Visits must only occur within daylight hours 0730 hrs to 1800 hrs
- Keep 2 metre distance from anyone not in your bubble
- We are required to keep a register of every person who enters our facility their name, contact details time and date of when on the premises.
- To comply with this, you must swipe your tag on the way in and on the way out <u>once the gate has</u> <u>closed.</u> This will capture your name, the time in and time out and save you and us having to record things manually.
- We have to collect this information in the event that contact tracing is required and if we do not keep this we can be shut down and fined. Please help us, help

- you and others by providing this every time you visit and walk onto the Marina piers.
- The Government is still asking people who are over 65 and not vaccinated to stay home.
- Berth owners/ occupiers if you have been unwell or had any flu like symptoms must stay home, selfisolate and should seek appropriate medical attention.
- BBYC Yacht Club management reserve the right to ask anyone to leave the premises, if they believe the individual is creating a risk to the Club and others or behaving inappropriately.
