NOTICE OF RACE

OPEN TO MEMBERS OF ANY YACHT CLUB

1. RULES:

- 1.1 The series will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in "The Racing Rules of Sailing."
- 1.2 The YNZ Safety Regulations shall apply. Keel Boats Part II Category 5.
- 1.3 In accordance with YNZ Safety Regulations Part II 3.2, a declaration of safety compliance will be required in the entry form.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 2.1 The series is open to all Farr 1020 Keelboats that are skippered by a current member of the Farr 1020 Association.
- 2.2 Farr 1020 Class Rules shall apply except where dispensation has been approved by the Farr 1020 committee in writing.
- 2.2.1 The use of furling headsails is permitted provide the sail fits within the class rules.
- 2.3 Entries will be accepted until 1700 hrs Monday 7th June 2021 by completing the attached entry form accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 and submitting to The Race Secretary, Bucklands Beach Yacht Club, P O Box 54 005, The Marina, Auckland 2144 or Fax 09 534 3242.
- To be eligible to complete in this series each skipper shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the skipper's national authority.
- 2.5 A minimum of five (5) boats must be entered before 1700hrs Monday 7th June 2021 for the series to be run otherwise any entry fees received will be refunded.
- 2.6 Boats can select to enter in the open or restricted divisions which will all be run as a single division, but handicapping adjustments will be made for boats that select restricted.
- 2.7 New Sails must be signed off by the class appointed measurer, sails that are older than 2 years can be declared class legal but must be presented for measuring at the end of racing it if a protest is lodged over sail eligibility.
- 2.8 Each yacht shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$3,000,000 per event. Evidence of insurance shall be provided by 1700 hrs 7th June 2021. The BBYC / Organising Authority encourages all owners to carry full racing insurance.

5. RACING AREA:

All races will be conducted in the area to the East or West of Browns Island.

6. COURSES TO BE SAILED:

The courses will be 7 Windward/Leeward Courses.

Courses are as per the BBYC General Course Sheet 20/21 (Page 36,37 and 38 of the Yearbook). Non BBYC members can obtain their course sheet from the BBYC Office between 0830 hrs and 1700 hrs weekdays or by request at racing@bbyc.org.nz from Tuesday 8th June 2021.

7. SCORING:

- 7.1 The Low Points Scoring System, Appendix A will apply.
- 7.2 Three (3) races will be required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.3 (a) When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 7.4 (b) When six to seven races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

8. PRIZES:

The Farr 1020 cups will be presented for first On Line and Handicap plus prizes as determined by entries at the prizegiving.

Prizegiving details to be confirmed at a later date.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
